Brief Problem Gambling Screen (3 item)

| In the past 12 months: | Yes No |
|---|--------|
| Have you needed to gamble with larger amounts of money to get the same feeling of excitement? | |
| Have you often gambled longer, with more money, or more frequently than you intended to? | |
| 3. Have you made attempts to either cut down, control, or stop gambling? | |

A "yes" to *any* of the questions means that the person is at risk for developing a gambling problem.

Consider proceeding to full screen to assess risk level.
